- 3. Minutes of the 9.9.21 meeting, Matters arising, and actions carried forward -
- 3.1. The minutes were agreed as a true record of the meeting.

- 3.9. No progress from Scottish Borders Cycling Development Group regarding training for our coaches/leaders to lead road training rides.
- 3.10. Members have been made aware through Facebook that they can apply for funding support from Clubsport Tweeddale as PCC is a member.
- 3.11. Young racing members have been made aware that applications for potential financial support from the club should be made through the secretary. No requests received to date.
- 3.12. Amy is the co-ordinator for first aid training for the "non-MTB" leaders/coaches.
- 3.13. Individuals to be invited to take up specific roles on the committee for 2022. **Action All**
- 3.14. It was suggested that we have a "Social Media" person (not necessarily on the committee), and that Jenny Routley be approached. **Action Andrew**
